Not all of the golf information appears in this online bulleting because it can be accessed on the LHSAA Website. To access the golf by-laws, click on "Sports", then "Golf", then "Important Dates & By-Laws." We urge you to save these documents on your hard drive in order to access them when you are not online. The rules pertaining to golf as stated in Section 15 of the 2011-12 LHSAA Handbook shall be followed.

Classifications

Boys' golf shall be divided into the following classifications for the purpose of regional qualifications and for state championship:

Tournament Dates

Regional tournaments shall be held throughout the state during the week of April 23-April 28 to qualify teams and medalists for compete in the LHSAA Boys' State Golf Tournament s. The state tournaments shall be held the week of April 30-May 5 at the sites listed in this bulletin.

Medalists

A "medalist" (in this sense) is defined as an individual golfing competitor, who might also be a member of a team, playing to have his individual score count towards an individual place and individual honors. (At the same time this individual golfer's score could also count toward his total team score.)

1. Teams or medalists wishing to enter the regional qualifying tournaments must enter the regional tournament as listed by regions and divisions in this bulletin. No entries will be accepted from schools outside a region where a meet is to be held.
2. Teams and medalists will qualify in each regional tournament for the state tournament as listed above.
3. All rules of play will be governed by The Rules of Golf published by the United States Golf Association except where local course rules are in effect and these listed in the LHSAA Handbook.

Team Scores: Only the scores of the four lowest players will be counted for the team score. In the event a school cannot enter a team (at least 4 players), it may enter less than four players to compete for medalist honors. All entries are competing for medalist honors to qualify for the state tournaments. If there is a tie in the team score, the coach of each tied team shall select a golfer to represent the team in a sudden-victory playoff beginning with the first hole. If there is a tie between the qualifying medalists, all of those medalists involved in this tie will advance to state tournament competition.

Entry Blanks

Entry Blanks must be postmarked no later than **Monday, April 16, 2012** and shall be mailed to the regional tournament director. The entry blank must be accompanied by a school check of \$10.00 per person entered, (up to a maximum of five entries or \$50.00) made payable to the LHSAA. **DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES TO THE LHSAA OFFICE!**

Coaching Supervision

A school shall not allow a non-faculty member to coach golf unless he/she has been properly certified through the LHSAA's Coaches Education Certification Program.

Spectators and Coaches on the Course

Spectators and coaches shall be allowed on the course. Only coaches shall be allowed to coach and/or converse with his/her golfer(s) and only from the green to the next tee box. No verbal contact shall be acceptable from spectators. *NOTE: Coaches may talk to players from the time he/she completes play on one hole until he/she tees off on the next hole.*

Practice

The golfers may not practice on the actual course on the actual dates of the tournament. When golfers report for their practice round, they are requested to practice as a team if at all possible (see format for practice times). The present plans call for an adult to accompany each group of golfers to serve as the rules advisor for each group. Each school is responsible for paying green fees at the courses at which they participate (if applicable.)

Markers

A "marker" is one who is appointed by the tournament director to record a competitor's score in a stroke play. He shall be a fellow-competitor. After each hole the marker should check score with the competitor and record it. After completion of the round, the competitor should check his score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the tournament director. He shall ensure that the marker has signed the card, countersign the card himself and return it to the tournament director.

The competitor is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole on his card. If he/she returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken he shall be disqualified. If he/she returns a score for any hole higher than actually taken, the score as returned shall stand.

Regional Golf Tournament

1. The regional qualifying tournament will be played over eighteen (18) holes for medal play.
2. A school may enter five players to play for team score or medalist honors.

NOTE: Only the scores of the four (4) lowest players will be counted for team score. A school may enter less than four (4) players to compete for medalist honors. If a school qualifies five medalists from the regional tournament and chooses to add substitutions to compete on the team at the state meet, the coach must specify in writing prior to the state tournament which medalists will not be considered in the team's score.

Immediately following their tournament, ***each regional director shall*** FAX a copy of the Regional Results to the State Tournament Director in their division immediately after the completion of the Regional Meet. A list of each team's alternates must be faxed to the state meet director by each regional director. Regional Results shall also be reported to the LHSAA by fax (225) 296-5919.

As soon as all qualifiers are reported from the regional directors, golfers will be grouped and assigned tee times for the state meet.

The tournament director is responsible for establishing a make-up date in the event of rain.

No trophies or medals will be awarded by the LHSAA in the regional qualifying tournaments.

Boys' Regional Golf Entry Form

Mail this entry blank to the tournament director of your regional tournament by **Monday, April 16, 2012** for your division and region. No entry blank will be accepted if postmarked after April 16. Your entry blank must be accompanied by your school check in the amount of \$10.00 per person that you have participating (up to a maximum of five entries or \$50.00). Make your check payable to the LHSAA. Schools that fail to meet established deadline dates for entries in regional events shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50) per entry up to a maximum of one hundred dollars (\$100). Late entries will be accepted in writing with the entry fee and the fine up to the time of the coaches meeting by the meet director. No entries may be accepted after the start of the coaches meeting. **DO NOT SEND TO THE LHSAA!!!**

2012 Boys State Golf Tournaments

The format for competition is outlined on the State Tournament chart attached to this bulletin. Only teams and medalists who qualify in the regional tournaments in their respective division may compete in the LHSAA State Championship Tournament. All team members are also competing for medalist honors.

If a golfer is disqualified in a regional golf tournament and his team qualifies for the state boys' tournament, he shall be permitted to compete as a team member only in the state tournament.

Rule 15.7.13: State Tournament- If a golfer is disqualified for any reason other than unsportsmanlike conduct (acts), he shall be allowed to participate in the other round of the tournament. If he is disqualified in the first round, he may participate in the second round. If disqualified in the second round, he may use his score from the first round.

Schools that qualify teams may substitute players for any one or more of the five original players prior to the start of the opening round on the first day of play only. All substitutions must come from the list of entries of alternates. No substitutions will be permitted for any reason after start of play in the opening round.

Scoring For State Golf Tournament

Rule 15.7.26 The scores of the four golfers posting the lowest legal scores each day will be totaled to determine the team's score. *Exception: In Division VI to compete for team honors and qualify as a team for the state tournament, a team shall have at least three qualifiers post complete scores.*

USGA rules shall apply except where local course rules are in effect and local course rules will be clearly defined to visiting participants.

The State Championship Tournament shall be 36 holes for medal play. In the event of a tie for team honors, each tied team's coach shall select a golfer to represent the team in a sudden victory beginning with the first hole. If there is a tie between medalists for first, second or third place, the golfers involved will play a sudden-death playoff beginning with the first tee. All sudden death playoffs shall be decided independent of each other.

Individual awards and a coach's award will be presented to the runner-up. Individual awards will be presented to the medalists, champion and runner-up.

Tee times will be strictly followed and there will be a coaches meeting on the first day of each tournament and all coaches should report at that time each day. If a golfer has not reported to the starter by the appointed time he/she shall be ruled as missing their tee time.

Inclement weather

If a round of play is cancelled because of inclement weather before all of the competitors have completed play on that day, the entire round shall be:

- **Cancelled** – if this occurs on the first day of play.
- **Cancelled** – if this occurs on the second day of play and the first day of play has been completed.
- **Suspended** – if this occurs on the second day of play and the first day of play has been canceled because of inclement weather and shall be completed on the next playable day that is approved by the Executive Director.

If either day of play in the state tournament is rained out in any division, the championship will be determined after a complete round of 18 holes of play.
