



## 2011 LHSAA GOLDEN TORCH AWARD

The Louisiana High School Athletic Association initiated the Golden Torch Award in 2005 to recognize a former LHSAA student athlete who went on to participate at the collegiate level. The nominee should exemplify the meaning of the term “student athlete,” and serve as a positive example and a role model for today’s high school student athletes.

One nomination is allowed per school and the deadline for submitting nominations is Friday November 4, 2011.
