

## **Soccer Online Clinic Instructions for Officials**

The 2011 soccer rules clinic for officials will be offered online from Monday, September 26 to Sunday, October 16. The online rules clinic consists of a video presentation and a 10 question quiz presented at the conclusion of the video. You must answer 8 out of 10 questions correctly in order to receive credit for attending the clinic. If you do not answer 8 questions correctly, you must view the video in its entirety and answer the questions again. You can view the presentation and take the quiz any time day or night during the assigned period.

The online rules clinic will be offered through our new LHSAA officials "portal". The portal is a website designed to provide officials a place to access officiating related applications and tasks like taking online rule clinics and exams. You will need a username and password to access this portal. Your assignment secretary should have this information for you.

Starting September 26, login to <http://www.lhsaaonline.org> using the username and password provided to you by your assignment secretary. Once you login into the system, download the Microsoft Silverlight program. This program must be downloaded in order to begin the clinic. Click on the "Online Soccer Clinic" link. This link will start the video presentation. You will NOT be able to pause the video, rewind it, or advance it. Once the video presentation is finished you will have 30 seconds to start the quiz. If you do not start the quiz in this period the system will not let you continue the quiz and you must start the video presentation from the beginning.

You have 15 minutes to answer the 10 questions. If you answer 8 correctly you will be credited with attending the clinic otherwise you must restart the presentation and take the quiz again until you can answer 8 questions correctly.
