

Wrestling Officials Test

The 2011 Wrestling Rules Test for officials will begin online on Monday, October 17 through Sunday October 30.

The online rules test will be offered through our new LHSAA officials “portal”. The portal is a website designed to provide officials a place to access officiating related applications and tasks like taking online rule clinics and exams. You will need a username and password to access this portal. Your assignment secretary should have this information for you.

Starting October 17 – October 30, login to <http://www.lhsaaonline.org> using the username and password provided to you by your Assignment Secretary. Once you login into the system, download the Microsoft Silverlight program. This program must be downloaded in order to begin the test. Click on the **“Online Wrestling Test”** link. This link will take you to an introductory page with the test instructions.

You will be given 50 minutes to answer 60 questions. If you do not make a passing grade of 70 or greater, you will be given an opportunity to retake the test. Please note that this test is a timed test and once you login to the wrestling questions, the time will begin. You can take the test any time day or night during the assigned period.

Once you finish the test, the system will calculate your score and let you know if you passed. If you failed the first time, you can re-take the test immediately or come back another day as long as the test is completed by the deadline.
