

SECTION 7: AWARDS

7.1 STATE CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION

7.1.1 The following awards shall be presented to the first and second place schools, team members, individuals and head coaches, if applicable.

7.1.2 Individual awards shall be presented to coaches of state championship and runner-up teams in all sports.

7.1.3 The number of individual awards presented in a sport shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

7.1.4 State championship and state runner-up trophy specifications shall be the same for all LHSAA contested championships.

7.1.5 If a first-place tie exists for the state championship in any sport in any class/division that cannot be broken, a runner-up trophy shall not be awarded.

7.2 SCHOOL AWARDS

7.2.1 All awards shall be approved by the principal.

7.2.2 No athletic award (*trophies, gift certificates, clothes, or other awards*) except those from the school shall be accepted by a team or an individual athlete before the end of the sport season in which the award is being made.

7.2.3 A student lettering in one sport or more than one sport shall receive only one sweater or jacket from the school, an outside organization, or an individual. The principal of each school shall determine the amount to be paid for a sweater or jacket earned by athletes in his/her school. Schools shall not award more expensive sweaters or jackets with students or outside organizations paying the cost over the amount approved by the principal.

7.2.4 Miniature awards may be awarded in other years with the cost of such awards being determined by the high school principal.

7.2.5 With the principal's approval, state championship schools may present team members state championship awards limited to \$150 each.

7.3 QUALIFYING FOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

7.3.1 Sports played in districts within classes: The number of teams competing for championship honors must equal total number of districts within that class. *Example: Nine-district class with 10 full teams competing: Team and individual awards will be presented since the number of competing teams is 9 or more.*

7.3.2 Sports played in districts within divisions: The number of teams competing for championship honors must equal the total number of districts within that division. *Example: Division III has 18 teams competing. The number of districts in the division is eight. Team and individual awards will be presented since the number of competing teams is eight or more.*

7.3.3 Sports played in division without districts: Eight full teams shall be required. *Example: A division has four full teams by what constitutes a complete team - only individual honors will be presented, if allotted.*
