LHSAA Announces 2023-24 Violation Free School of Distinction Awards

BATON ROUGE– The Louisiana High School Athletic Association has awarded 63 state institutions as a School of Distinction for being violation free during the 2023-2024 athletic season. This esteemed recognition, formally introduced by the LHSAA following the 2021-2022 athletic year, aims to acknowledge and honor those athletic departments that have successfully completed an entire year free from any infractions or violations of the association's established rules and regulations.

Notably, 24 of these award recipients are first-time honorees. Over the past three years, a cumulative total of 194 schools have maintained a commendable record, free from any violations within a given academic year. Additionally, 47 schools have distinguished themselves by securing this prestigious award multiple times.

Institutions that have achieved this distinction will be given a commemorative LHSAA School of Distinction retractable banner in recognition of their unwavering dedication to adhering to the regulations established by the LHSAA.
